Permaculture Design

This is a three part, accredited Permaculture Design Course; each weekend can stand alone if preferred (accredited by Aberystwyth University). However, all 3 modules are required to apply for a Permaculture Design Certificate awarded by the Permaculture Association.

The focus of these courses is how to meet fundamental human needs more sustainably. There is a particular emphasis on how we can design things to work well together.

You will develop your own portfolio of small, achievable designs through projects carried out during and between each weekend, with support and feedback from the tutor team.



This will culminate in a larger design exercise over the last weekend – an opportunity for you to apply / integrate your learning throughout the course.

Tutors Dr Angie Polkey & Dr Kate Hamilton have over 25 years combined experienced in permaculture design and teaching, complemented by inspirational site visits to nearby permaculture practitioners.
